

BUTTONED FRENCH PRESS COZY

Sometimes your French Press wants to wear a sweater. I mean, how else is it going to keep that delicious dirty bean water warm? This coffee press cozy knits up quickly and uses less than 20 grams of sock yarn. All you need is one mini-skein, three buttons, and a pair of needles!

Finished Size

Approximately 12.5" x 4.5"

Materials

Recommended Yarn

Lattes & Llamas Vacation Yarn in "Saint Thomas"

Needles

US 1 / 2.25mm 32" circular needles

Notions

Needle, matching thread, 3 – 12mm buttons

Gauge

29 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Stockinet

INSTRUCTIONS

CO 90

Rows 1-5: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 6: k 2, BO 3, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 7: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 2 sts remain, CO 3, k 2

Rows 8-10: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 11: k 5, (k 8, p 2, k 1, p 2, k 1, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 12: k 5, (k 8, p 8) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Rows 13-25: repeat rows 11-12. Please note that you will end on a R 11.

Row 26: k 2, BO 3, (k 8, p 8) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Abbreviation Key

Please note that we use the American definitions.

BO Bind off
CO Cast on
K Knit

P Purl
R Row
st(s) Stich(es)



Row 27: k 5, (k 8, p 2, k 1, p 2, k 1, p 2) until 2 sts remain, CO 3, k 2

Rows 28-40: repeat rows 11-12

Rows 41-43: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 44: k 2, BO 3, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

Row 45: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 2 sts remain, CO 3, k 2

Rows 46-50: k 5, (k 2, p 2) until 5 sts remain, k 5

BO. Sew buttons onto garter edge to match button holes. Weave in ends and enjoy!
