

SOCK DRAWER SACHET

What should you knit for the woman who loves to smell pretty and pamper herself? A Sock Drawer Sachet! This small knitted pouch works up quickly and can hold your favorite potpourri to keep your sock drawers smelling beautiful.

Finished Size

2.5" x 3.5"

Materials

Recommended Yarn

Lattes & Llamas Vacation Yarn in "Saint Thomas"

Needles

US 1 / 2.25mm DPNs

Gauge

29 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Stockinet



Notions

Tapestry Needle, Potpourri

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: The sachet is knit into a rectangular piece and then seamed together to form a triangle.

SACHET

CO 26

Row 1-3: knit

Row 4: k 3, p 20, k 3

Row 5: knit

Repeat rows 4 – 5 an additional 13 times, for a combined total of 28 SKN rows.

Row 32-34: knit

Repeat rows 1-34. BO.

ASSEMBLY

Fold piece in half so that wrong sides are together, sew row 1 to the last row. Lining up R 1-34 with 35-68, seam one side closed. You should now have a pocket. Begin filling the sachet with your favorite potpourri as we close the final seam. Using the pictures above as a guide, line up the garter rows (R 32-37 with R 1-3/66-68) and seam closed. Weave in ends and enjoy!

Abbreviation Key

Please note that we use the American definitions.

BO Bind off

CO Cast on

K Knit

P Purl

R Row

SKN Stockinet: Knit on the right side and purl on the wrong side.
