

# Fingerish Mitts

These gloves are the perfect accent to any scarf pattern. You could easily knit them in just two, or even 1 color if desired, and since they are made with worsted weight yarn they knit up quickly. The fingers make them an intermediate knit, but beginners shouldn't be scared off of them, they are a great way to up your skill level!



#### Materials

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#### Recommended Yarn

1 ball each Classic Elite Yarns Liberty Wool (50g/120 yards) in Slate (color A), Ash Gray (color B), and Ebony (color C).

#### Needles

US 7 36" circular needles for working in magic loop (optional, you could use DPNs throughout), and US 7 DPNs, or size needed to obtain gauge.

#### Notions

Stich Markers, waste yarn for holding stitches.

#### Gauge


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Sizes are given as Small(Medium, Large).

# Special Stitches

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M1 (Make 1): To M1 you will pick up the bar between sts and knit it, which increases 1. To M1 pick up the bar between the stitch you knit and the stitch you are about to knit (the bar is to the LEFT of the stitch you just knit) and knit it before knitting the next st.



#### Abbreviation Key

ВО	Bind off
CO	Cast on
K	Knit

K2tog Knit two together (decreases one)

M Marker

M1 Make 1 (see special stitches)

P Purl

PM Place Marker

P2tog Purl two stitches together (decreases one).

R Row

SKS Slip, Knit, Slip: slip one as if to knit, knit next stitch,

pass slipped stitch over knit stitch (decreases one).

SKN Stockinette: Knit on the right side and purl on the

wrong side.

Sl Slip stitch to right needle without working it.

St(s) Stitch(es)



# INSTRUCTIONS

#### **CUFF**

CO: Using Color A and the long tail method of your choice, CO 40(46, 50) sts.

R1-12: Join to work in the round, and place M to mark beginning of row. K1, P1 around.

**R13:** K.

#### Hand

R1-2: K with color B. R3-4: K with color C. R5-6: K with color A.

Continue in established stripe pattern until you have completed 8(9, 10) stripes.

#### Thumb Gusset

Continue working in established stripe pattern as you complete the gusset instructions. End on the second row of your last stripe.

R1: Left hand: K4, PM, K1, M1, K2, M1, K1, PM, K to end. Right hand: K to 8 before end, PM, K1, M1, K2, M1, K1, PM, K to end

**R4:** K

K1, slip M, K to end.

M1, K2, M1, K1, PM, K to end.

**R2:** K

Repeat rows 3-4 until there are 12(14, 16) sts between markers.

**Next row:** K to M. Remove M. Place next 12(14, 16) sts on a scrap yarn to hold them and remove the second M. Using the Cable Cast On, CO 4 sts. K to end.

Next row: K

**Next row:** Left hand: K3, SKS, K2, K2tog, K to end. Right hand: K to 9 before end, SKS, K2, K2tog, K to end. 42(48, 52) sts.

Next row: K

# Fingers & Thumb (both hands)

Instructions from here on use color A unless otherwise noted.

### Pinky

1. K 26(28, 30). Put next 12(14, 16) sts on scrap yarn holder. Turn and P 10(11, 12), then put remaining 15(17, 19) sts on scrap yarn holder.

#### Ring

1. Using DPNs, pick up and knit 5(5, 6) sts from the scrap yarn to the right of the pinky, then pick up and knit 5 from the bottom edge of the pinky, then pick up and knit 5(6, 6) from the scrap yarn to the left of the pinky.

**2.** Distribute sts evenly onto 3 DPNs, k across sts, and CO 3 at the end of the row. Join to work in the round.

**R3:** K to M, slip M. K1, M1, K to 1 before M, M1,

- **3.** K3(5, 6) rows.
- **4.** K1P1 for 2 rows, BO.
- **2.** CO 3 sts, distribute sts evenly onto 3 DPNs, and join to work in the round.
- **3.** K 1 row, decreasing 3 by K2tog. 15(16, 17) sts
- **4.** K 3(5, 6) rows.
- **5.** K1P1 for 2 rows, BO.



#### Middle

1. Using DPNs, pick up and knit 5(6, 6) sts from the scrap yarn to the right of the ring, then pick up and knit 5 from the bottom edge of the ring, then pick up and knit 5(5, 6) from the scrap yarn to the left of the ring.

#### Pointer

1. Using DPNs, pick up and knit 5(5, 6) sts from the scrap yarn to the right of the middle, then pick up and knit 5 from the bottom edge of the middle, then pick up and knit 5(6, 6) from the scrap yarn to the left of the middle.

- **2.** CO 3 sts, distribute sts evenly onto 3 DPNs, and join to work in the round.
- **3.** K 1 row, decreasing 3 by K2tog. 15(16, 17) sts
- **4.** K 3(5, 6) rows.
- **5.** K1P1 for 2 rows, BO.
- **2.** Distribute sts evenly onto 3 DPNs, and join to work in the round.
- **3.** K 4(6, 7) rows.
- **4k.** K1P1 for 2 rows, BO.

#### Thumb

- 1. Using color C and DPNs, pick up and knit the 12(14, 16) sts from the scrap yarn holder, then pick up and knit 6 from the cast on edge where the thumb meets the hand. 20(22, 24) sts
- 2. Distribute sts evenly onto 3 DPNs, and join to work in the round. K 1 row.
- 3. \*K 1 row, decreasing 3 evenly spaced around by K2tog. Rep from \* twice more. 14(16, 18) sts.
- **4.** K (3(4, 5) rows.
- **5.** K1P1 for 2 rows, BO.

# Finishing

- 1. Weave in all ends and lightly block (blocking is really optional on gloves that don't have extensive color work).
- 2. Enjoy!
