Twisted Knitter Socks

Intertwining cables that grow and shrink climb the foot and leg of this mysterious sock. Luscious cashmere and silk Interlude yarn make the project as fun to wear as it is to knit. Can you untangle the mystery of the Twisted Knitter socks?

Materials

Recommended Yarn

1 ball Lattes and Llamas Interlude Yarn

Needles

US 1 36" circular needles for working in magic loop or size needed to obtain gauge.

Notions

Stitch Markers, Stitch Holder, Cable Needle

Gauge

30 sts and 40 rows = 4" in Stockinette

Sizes

Small(Medium, Large, XL)

Abbreviation Key

BO	Bind off	R	Row
CO	Cast on	SKS	Slip, Knit, Slip: slip one as if to knit, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch (decreases one).
CDD	Center Double Decrease. Slip 2 as if to K2tog. K next st. Pass slipped sts over knit st.	SKN	Stockinette: Knit on the right side and purl on the wrong side.
CN	Cable Needle	Sl	Slip stitch to right needle without working it.
K	Knit	St(s)	Stitch(es)
KFB	Knit into front and back.	Tbl	Through the back loop. (knit into the back of the stitch).
K2tog	Knit two together (decreases one)	W	Wrap
M	Marker		
P	Purl		
PM	Place Marker		
P2tog	Purl two stitches together (decreases one).
